



HOW TO APPLY TO CFS

Visit Our School

Call to sign up for a Tuesday morning tour (weekly) for parents only, an Open House Information Session (twice a year), or make an individual appointment with our Director of Admissions, Robin Dellabough.

Complete the Application Packet

As soon as possible after your visit, complete the *Application for Admission, Parent/Guardian Questionnaire, and Transcript Release*. Examples of recent student work are required and students age nine and over should complete a *Student Questionnaire*. Mail these forms to the Admissions Office along with the \$70 application fee. If any psycho-educational testing has been done in the past three years, please submit these test results as well.

If you will be applying for financial assistance, please request and complete the *School and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS) Form* from the Admissions Office.

Schedule a Student Visit

The Admissions Office will contact you to schedule an appointment for your child. For incoming Maples (Kindergarten/1st grade), this is a two-hour visit in the morning. Older students spend a full day in the classroom with their peers.

Review the CFS Family Handbook

We request all parents familiarize themselves with our handbook, which describes the school's philosophy, curriculum, expectations of students and parents, as well as practical information.
